Topic: The imposition of stricter gun regulations

Preambulatory Clauses:

Deeply disturbed, by the growing gun violence epidemic in our country.

Firmly Convinced, that the rights pronounced in the Second Amendment are inalienable and must be protected at all costs.

Stressing, the importance of making schools a safe space for students.

Recognizing, the potential that the absence of trigger locks on AK-47's and AR-15's creates for accidents.

Welcoming, the proposal from the Democratic Party to ban criminals convicted of domestic abuse from obtaining a gun.

Operative Clauses:

1. *Proclaims* that public school budgets shall be increased to give students greater access to quality mental health care at the expense of the state.
 - a. These funds shall be redirected from social security programs like medicare and medicaid.
2. *Demands* that small businesses selling guns tax subsidies in order to promote their businesses and create jobs.
3. *Has resolved* to create the *save the children program* in which certain teachers in all public schools, reviewed by an independent commission that will be appointed by individual state's legislatures, will be provided with a handgun and extensive training to use it.
 - a. Funding for these weapons and the training programs shall be acquired from further cuts to overfunded social security programs.
4. *Suggests* the implementation of moderate background checks that scan every potential candidate to receive a gun for a past criminal record of domestic abuse and violent conduct, on top of existing regulations.
5. *Instructs* for the passage of a law that requires all newly sold AK-47's and AR-15's to be equipped with trigger locks.
 - a. Automatic assault rifles that are already in the possession of an individual will not be required to be turned in to include this feature.
